All bills are current. There is one outstanding assessment and we are following up.

Snow:

Facilities:

The Trash company switch from Casella to County waste has gone surprising smooth. We do need to keep in mind the reason for the lower cost to us is connected to the technology of the automated truck being used, which requires on one driver. Stone Industries has completed their quarterly pumping of the pump stations. We have had no problems with clogged pumps since we started this process. However it is very important that we keep reminding the residents that they need to restrict what gets flushed to human waste.
